About

If an Insurance Payer does not cover a specific Activity Code for all clients who have that insurance coverage, an exclusion can be added at the payer level.

Exclude Activity Code for an Insurance Payer

- 1. Navigate to Activity Code Insurance Exclusion List by following the path above.
- 2. Select an Activity Code.
- 3. Click the Act Code Ins Exclusions button. The Activity Code Insurance Exclusion List is displayed.

- 9. Click the Save button.
