When setting up Activity Codes within the Billing Engine, if an Activity is billable for a particular Party Type, you need to complete the Activity Code Insurance Form information for the Activity Code. In this window, you will select a Billing Rate Code associated with the Activity Code and Party Type. The Billing Rate Code is a hardcoded list of calculation rules for the number of units and dollar amounts. Below you fill find a table of the most commonly used Billing Rate Codes.

Billing Rate Codes and Descriptions

| Rate Code | Description |
|-----------|--|
| 1 | Flat Rate Line Item Billable |
| 5 | Half-hour Units Billable |
| A | Time Based- 15 Minutes (rounded up/down) |
| В | Time Based - 15 Minutes (no rounding) |
| D | Time Based - 1 Hour (no rounding) |
| Е | Time Based - 1 Hour (round up to next hour) |
| F | Time Based - 1 Minute |
| G | Time Based - 1 Hour (round up to next hour at 50 minutes) |
| 1 | Time Based - (0-7 min: 0, 8-24:1, 25-39:2, 40-49:3, 50-60:4) |
| J | Half-hour Units (Rounded up at 15 minutes) |
| K | Time Based - 15 Minutes (round up at 8 minutes) (qty of 1) |
| L | Time Based - 15 Minute Units (Prorated amount per minute) |
