On the Dose tab in NextStep Dispensing, there are currently two checkboxes, one for **Blind Dose** and another **Extended Take Home Override**. These checkboxes can now be enabled or disabled by users with access to the Utilities menu, under Global Settings. Please note that this applies to all users.

Ability to enable or disable the Blind Dose and Extended Take Home Override checkboxes
