On the Census Billing page, currently the Program dropdown displays, by default, all programs. However you can now set up NextStep to show only the programs the client was in during the selected Census Date.  • In System Setup (Supplemental) → Census Billing use the toggle to select either:  • Display all programs, or  • Only display the client's programs.
Census Billing: Rearrange the sequence order in which Programs appear	In System Setup (Supplemental) → Billing Configuration, for the Program field, click + to set the order that you want the Programs to appear in the Census Billing dropdown.
